Parking lot and Bus lane

Please use the south parking lot when arriving at school with a vehicle. Pay attention to the *No Parking* signs and yellow and blue curbing in front of the school. These areas are NOT to be used to park vehicles, attended or unattended, for any length of time. By-law enforcement and the Fire



Department authorities help us monitor this area throughout the year and can issue \$80 parking tickets.


Also, do not enter the bus lane when dropping off or picking up your child, specifically between 8:15 – 8:55 and again between 3:00 – 3:40. If you are parked behind the Rec Center or Community Hall, use the sidewalk to go to and from the school. For safety reasons we ask all students to do this, so the adults must as well. We also ask that parents parked in this area not use the bus lane to cut through to the main road.

Parents, Guardians & Visitors in the school

Parents and guardians if you have something to drop off for your child or a message to deliver, please go directly to the office. Parents are to stay in the office area and we will call down your child. This is for the safety of our students and staff and less disruptions during instructional time. If you need to speak with your child's teacher, please arrange with them a time and date to meet.

We also ask that parents wait outside in the morning and after school to drop off or pick your child.

Student Illness- If your child has Covid-19 symptoms

If your child has any of these symptoms you are legally required to isolate for at least 10 days from the onset of symptoms OR receive a negative COVID-19 test and feel better before returning. Please continue to use the <u>Alberta Health Daily Checklist</u>

- · Fever
- · Cough (new cough or worsening chronic cough)
- · Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing (new or worsening)
- · Loss of sense of smell or taste

Student Messages or changes of plans

Using your child's Agenda or sending a note for your child's homeroom teacher letting them know when daily routines are going to change, is the best way to communicate. This greatly reduces the chance that a message gets lost. When this is absolutely NOT possible and information has to be passed along to children please call the office **BEFORE 3:00 PM**, leaving office staff sufficient time before dismissal.



Student Absences

If you know ahead of time of an appointment for your child, please notify the homeroom teacher. Should an absence not be known in advance please call the school first thing in the morning as attendance is done by 9:15 AM. A phone call will be made home if we are unaware of your child's absence.

Any student arriving after 10:00 am will be absent on the attendance for that morning. If students must leave before 1:00 pm they will be marked absent for the afternoon.

Student Fees/Powerschool Parent Portal

Invoices will be sent home this week for student fees as well as your access ID for Powerschool Parent Portal. We ask that all parents sign up through Powerschool Portal to pay fees and have access to various forms.

The Demographic Verification forms have been uploaded to Powerschool Parent portal. This updates your vital information with us. We recommend that you do this on a computer versus your cell phone.

Please go to our school website and click on "Student & Parent Info", then choose "online payment system".

Breakfast Program

Our school canteen known as the Den is not available at this time. With COVID-19 related protocols, we are not sure when or if the Den will reopen.

However, we are excited to once again offer a breakfast snack to all interested students beginning Tuesday, September 7. Healthy, nutritious choices will be featured including dry cereal, milk, yogurt, and cheese as we get the program up and running. All health measures and protocols will be strictly followed in the preparation and distribution of food and drink.
