I hope that everyone has a wonderful Thanksgiving and takes the time to enjoy the long weekend with your family and reflect on all the things we are thankful for.

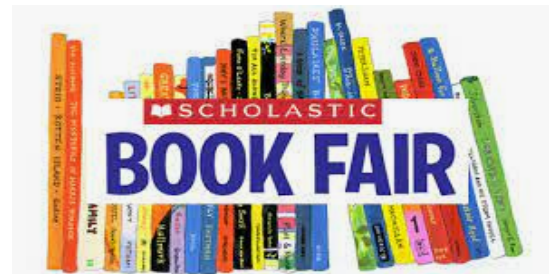
