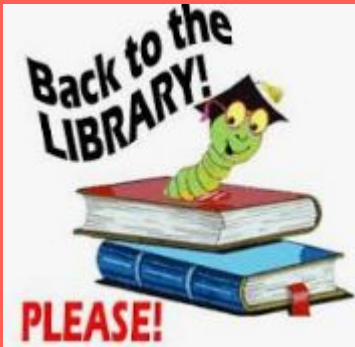
There is also parking behind the swimming pool/community center.
